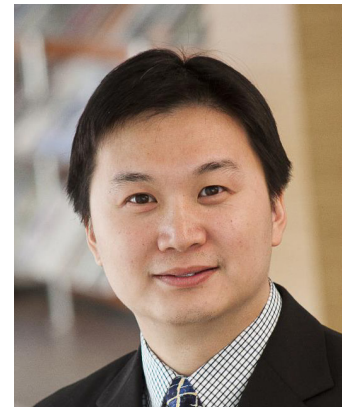
Washington, DC (February 2016) KCCT is pleased to announce the promotion, activities and licensure of the following staff members:
