Construction of New Embassy Compound Begins

- Construction recently began on the new U.S. Embassy Compound in Belgrade, Serbia located on a 9.4 acre site adjacent to the historic former King's Palace residence. The design-build project totals more than 154,000 square feet, and includes a New Office Building, Marine Security Guard Quarters, three Compound Access Control Buildings, and other support buildings.
- The façade of the office incorporates various granite and marble stone cladding and aluminum composite wall panels. This composition of materials conveys a contemporary yet refined aesthetic that is sensitive to other buildings within the historic neighborhood. The project will pursue LEED® Silver certification for its sustainable design that maximizes energy and water efficiency.
