Project Awarded: Baghdad Housing

Framaco Epik Joint Venture has contracted KCCT to provide design services for a four-story barracks building on the East End Compound of the United States Embassy site in Baghdad, Iraq. This undeveloped portion of the site originally used as a staging area for construction will support expanded staff housing and related infrastructure. The additional barracks will consist of 584 dormitory rooms, a power building, improvements to the dining facility and fire station, and two waste water treatment plants. The design-build project will be completed in 18 months.
